Scholarship Description

A \$50 scholarship is available for those interested in taking the Indiana Master Naturalist (IMN) course presented by Ball State University, Purdue Extension-Delaware County, and Red-tail Land Conservancy in the fall of 2022. The scholarship takes the form of a reduced registration cost. Registration still must be paid in full before the start of the class.

Each form will be reviewed as they are submitted. Applicants will be notified within 5 business days if they have received the scholarship.

Deadline for the application is Monday, August 22, 2022. Applications will no longer be accepted after all available scholarships have been issued or the class is full.



Applicant Eligibility

IMN serves adult learners. All attendees must be 18 years or older. To the best of their ability, applicants of this scholarship should expect to:

- Attend at least 8 classes
- Complete and pass the final exam
- Complete at least 5 hours of volunteer service
- Sign the IMN creed
