# **RED-TAIL NATURE PRESERVE**


Made up of forests, tallgrass prairie, and wetlands, Red-tail Nature Preserve is an enchanting example of a wildlife corridor. Located between Prairie Creek Reservoir and the Cardinal Greenway, this preserve connects two significant wildlife habitats and recreation areas. A loop trail circles Edgar H. and Lois C. Seward Memorial Prairie. Late summer is an excellent time to visit the native grasses and wildflowers in full bloom. The nearby reservoir is a vital stopping place for migratory waterfowl and home for hawks, osprey, and eagles.

# **FALL CREEK WOODS**



# McVEY MEMORIAL FOREST






# **DUTRO-ERNST WOODS**

The walking trail crosses through a prairie-in-restoration, young forest, older trees and wetland. Because of

restoration, native plant and wildlife populations are increasing and beginning to thrive. Children enjoy the nature playground. Stop by often to observe seasonal transitions and changes in the land.

## STOUT MEMORIAL WOODLAND



## WHITE RIVER WOODS


